Our Sin

Revelation 1:5 – ...and from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood...

Isaiah 53:5-6,8,10-12 – ⁵ But he was **pierced for our transgressions**; he was **crushed for our iniquities**; upon him was the **chastisement** that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has **laid on him the iniquity of us all**. ⁸ By oppression and judgment he was taken away; and as for his generation, who considered that he was cut off out of the land of the living, stricken **for the transgression of my people**? ¹⁰ Yet it was the will of the Lord to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes **an offering for guilt**, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the Lord shall prosper in his hand. ¹¹ Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall **bear their iniquities**. ¹² Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he **bore the sin of many**, and **makes intercession for the transgressors**.

1 Peter 2:24 – He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness...

1 John 1:7 – ...the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

Hebrews 9:26 – ...he has appeared once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself.

Satan

Mark 1:21-39 – ²¹ ...on the Sabbath he entered the synagogue and was teaching. ²² And they were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one who had authority, and not as the scribes. ²³ And immediately there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, ²⁴ “What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God.” ²⁵ But Jesus rebuked him, saying, “Be silent, and come out of him!” ²⁶ And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying out with a loud voice, came out of him. ²⁷ And they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, “What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him.” ³² That evening at sundown they brought to him all who were sick or oppressed by demons... ³⁴ And he healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons. ³⁹ And he went throughout all Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and casting out demons.

1 John 3:8 – The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.

John 12:31 – Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out.

Colossians 2:15 – He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

Hebrews 2:14-15 – ¹⁴ Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil— ¹⁵ and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

Revelation 12:10-11 – ¹⁰ ...for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God. ¹¹ And they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb...

Our Sorrow

Isaiah 53:4 – Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering...

1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 – ¹³ But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. ¹⁴ For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.

Psalms 30:5 – ...Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

Isaiah 25:8 – He will swallow up death forever; and the Lord God will wipe away tears from all faces, and the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the Lord has spoken.

Revelation 7:17 – For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”

Revelation 21:4 – He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.”

Psalms 16:11 – You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.

Isaiah 35:10 – Gladness and joy will overtake them, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.

Our Sickness and Weakness

Isaiah 53:4 – Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering...

Isaiah 53:5 – But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

Matthew 8:16-17 – ¹⁶ When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. ¹⁷ This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: “He took up our infirmities and bore our diseases.”

Psalms 103:3 – who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases

The Legal Demands of the Law

Colossians 2:13-15 – ¹³ And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, ¹⁴ by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. ¹⁵ He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

Galatians 3:10-14 – ¹⁰ For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, “Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them.” ¹¹ Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for “The righteous shall live by faith.” ¹² But the law is not of faith, rather “The one who does them shall live by them.” ¹³ Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree”— ¹⁴ so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith.

James 2:10 – ...whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of all of it.

Galatians 3:23-24 – ²³ Now before faith came, we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed. ²⁴ So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith.

Slavery to the Fear of Death

Hebrews 2:14-15 – ¹⁴ Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil— ¹⁵ and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death. (NIV)

¹⁴ Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, so that through death He might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, ¹⁵ and free those who through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives. (NASB)
